LABOR DAY RACE - - SEP 4, 2011 NOTICE OF RACE AND GENERAL CONDITIONS

MANAGEMENT: The race will be managed by the joint Race Committees of Silver Gate Yacht Club and Oceanside Yacht Club, who shall have authority to interpret the rules and conditions of the race, to decide protests, and to reject the entry of any yacht, at any time prior to the Preparatory Signal for the start of the race, that in its opinion is un-seaworthy, or does not comply with the letter or spirit of the rules and conditions of the race.

SCHEDULE: The race will start approximately one-half mile off the Oceanside Pier on Sunday, Sep 4, 2011. The first warning signal will be made at 11:25 AM.

RULES: This race shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 – 2012, USSA prescriptions, rules of the classes sailing, the Sailing Instructions for this race, and this Notice of Race and General Conditions.

ELIGIBILITY: The race is open to sailing yachts designed and built to go offshore and having a minimum overall length of 23 feet LOA or longer. Eligible yachts must file an entry using the attached form with Silver Gate Yacht Club, 2091 Shelter Island Drive, San Diego, CA 92106 **no later than 1700, Tues, Aug 30, 2011**. All participants must be pre-registered. Entry forms must be legible and filled out completely before they will be accepted. Yachts competing in PHRF Fleets shall be those who possess a current Rating Certificate from PHRF Southern California or current Membership Certificate from PHRF San Diego. The race will be scored using PHRF Area G OWC rating.

CLASSES: There will be two fleets; one for PHRF rated yachts (spinnaker and non-spinnaker) and one for SGYC Family Fleet. Each of these fleets may be divided into smaller classes. Skippers will be notified in the sailing instructions as to the class in which they are to compete. Class breaks and pennant colors will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

The PHRF non-spin class must have at least 3 entrants to constitute a class. In case there are only one or entries, they will race with the SGYC Family Fleet as guests and the entry fee will be returned.

COURSE: ALL Classes: After starting, San Diego Entrance Buoy SD "3" to port.

FINISH: - San Diego channel entrance buoy "7" to STARBOARD on a transit of SD Buoy 7 and 8.

Finish Deadline: 10:00 A.M., Monday, Sep 5, 2011. **Distance:** 36.50nm

SAFETY EQUIPMENT: All yachts shall comply with their respective fleet safety requirements. All yachts shall satisfy the requirements for a Category II race.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS will be available at SGYC at 1800 on Thursday, Sep 1 and at OYC.

► **SLIPS and FACILITIES:** Entrants must make their own berthing arrangements with the Jolly Roger Marina or the Oceanside Harbor. Reciprocity is offered at OYC on a reserved basis. For more information go to <http://www.oceansideyc.com/pages/visitingyachtsman.html> Reservations for dinner at OYC on Sep 3 must be made 5 days in advance. **SGYC** members who raft up at SMYC must complete the appropriate paper work required for taking their boat into the marine facility. **Racers requiring a slip at SGYC on Sep 4-5 must contact the SGYC Office at 619-222-1214 immediately with your contact & yacht information and yacht club affiliation for reservations.**

TROPHY PRESENTATION: The Trophy Presentation will be held on Monday, Sep 5, 2011 at 1100 at SGYC. Take home trophies will be awarded to the first PHRF Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker yachts to finish and winners in each class. Regular SGYC Family Fleet trophies will also be presented.

I assume all risk of damage to property or injury to persons arising out of my participation in the race or regatta and related activities.

I further agree to notify SGYC and OYC immediately upon withdrawal from the race and not to sail in hazardous conflict with commercial shipping.
