Jr. Flag/Joint Jr. Flag: Shall have an appropriate interest in yachting; may be on the slip waiting list; may serve as a committee member; has full privileges to use club for social purposes.

Associate: Shall have an appropriate interest in yachting; may serve as a committee member; has full privileges to use club for social purposes.

Junior Member: Under 21 years of age; must renew annually; may be assigned one dry storage space (subject to availability)

Applicants 29 or younger pay 1/2 of the initiation fee for the applicable membership category.

If you are applying for Flag/Joint Flag or Junior Flag/Joint Junior Flag, the Port Captain of SGYC must inspect your boat and documentation, such as proof of ownership and insurance, prior to your application being presented to the Board of Directors.

Note: Members may not live aboard their boats except on weekends and for short vacations unless they qualify for live-aboard status. Live-aboard status requires three full years of membership and the approval of the Live-Aboard Chair.
