Jr. Flag/Joint Jr. Flag: Shall have an appropriate interest in yachting; may be on the slip waiting list; may serve as a committee member; has full privileges to use club for social purposes.

Associate: Shall have an appropriate interest in yachting; may serve as a committee member; has full privileges to use club for social purposes.

Junior Member: Under 21 years of age; must renew annually; may be assigned one dry storage space (subject to availability)

Applicants 29 or younger pay 1/2 of the initiation fee for the applicable membership category. Refer to SGYC By-Laws, Rules and Policies for full disclosure of requirements and rights of these categories.
